Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that bye-laws approved by the District Registrar, Gurgaon on 13.5.2015 were challenged by the petitioners by way of an appeal, filed under Section 79 of the Haryana Registration and Regulations of Societies, Act 2012 [for short 'the Act'], which was allowed on 1.10.2015 by the State Registrar of Societies, Haryana and the matter was remanded back to the District Registrar, Gurgaon for passing a speaking order after hearing both the parties. It is submitted that after the remand, the matter is lying with the District Registrar, Gurgaon from the last four months but neither he has taken up the application for stay nor the matter remanded to him is decided by passing a speaking order after hearing both the parties. It is further submitted that pendency of the case before the District Registrar, Gurgaon is adversely

affecting the rights of the petitioners and therefore, the present petition has been filed.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has made an innocuous prayer for disposing of this petition by directing the District Registrar, Gurgaon, who is seized of the matter, to decide the same in a time bound manner.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioners and perusal of the order Annexure P-3 i.e. order dated 1.10.2015 passed by the State Registrar of Societies, Haryana, this petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to District Registrar, Gurgaon, who is seized of the matter of the petitioners, after remand, to decide the same as early as possible, preferably within two months from the date of presentation of certified copy of the order passed by this Court. It is needless to mention that in case, the application for interim direction is pressed by the petitioners, allegedly pending before the District Registrar, Gurgaon, the same shall be decided at the first instance.
