Through the present petition, the petitioner seeks change of his designation from Mali to Petrol Pump Attendant as has been done in the case of respondent No.5 his alleged junior.

In the written statement filed on behalf of respondent-Corporation it has been submitted that applications have been invited from all the Malis of the respondent-Corporation who were keen to be appointed as Petrol Pump Attendants, in pursuance to which the petitioner has also submitted an application. It is further submitted that the application filed by the petitioner along with other applications so received are under consideration.

The written statement was filed in December 2014 and Court is informed that till date no final decision has been taken on the aforesaid

received applications.

In view of the above, at this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he would be satisfied if the respondent-Corporation is directed to take a final decision on the above referred applications received by it for filling up posts of Petrol Pump Attendant from Malis for which the petitioner has also submitted his application.

I consider the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner to be reasonable.

Accordingly, at this stage, without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent-Corporation to take a final decision on the above referred applications expeditiously, preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Disposed of in the above terms.
