The petitioners are residents of village Dabwala Kalan, Tehsil & District Fazilka. They allege that the two streets in their village through which they have access to their houses are not being constructed by the Punjab Mandi Board due to internal politics though these are duly sanctioned and are to be made pakka under the 'Pardhanmantri Gram Sarak Yojna'. A complaint against non-construction of these streets appears to have been made by the petitioners to various authorities including the Deputy Commissioner, Fazilka (P-6).

Taking into consideration the nature of relief sought but without expressing any views on the allegations, we dispose of this writ petition with a direction to the Deputy

Commissioner, Fazilka to ascertain the correct facts and take remedial steps in accordance with the Government Scheme/ law, within a period of four months from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order.

Ordered accordingly.
