Instant writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari quashing order dated 05.04.2013 (Annexure P/1) passed by respondent No.3 – Divisional Canal Officer, Rohtak Water Services Division, Rohtak, order dated 05.09.2013 (Annexure P/2) passed by respondent no.2 – Superintending Canal Officer, Y.W.S. Circle, Rohtak and order dated 30.06.2014 (Annexure P/3) passed by respondent No.1 – Chief Canal Officer, LCU Irrigation and W.R. Department, Haryana.

During the pendency of the writ petition, parties have effected compromise.

Learned State counsel states that in pursuance of compromise, needful has been done vide order dated 27.05.2016 passed by Chief Canal
