Notice of motion to respondent Nos.1 to 3 only at this stage.

On our asking, Ms.Kirti Singh, learned Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on their behalf.

Let four copies of the writ petition be supplied to the State counsel during the course of day failing which this order shall be automatically recalled and the writ petition shall stand dismissed for non-prosecution.

The petitioner's nomination for contesting the election of Sarpanch of Village Kurar, Tehsil Safidon, District Jind is said to have

been rejected for want of eligibility of 8th class academic qualification. The petitioner relies upon a school leaving certificate issued by SKV, 'O' Block Mangolpuri, Delhi according to which her date of birth is 17.7.1976. She was admitted to the school on 22.7.1987 and left it on 31.3.1990.

On our asking and very fairly, learned counsel for the petitioner has shown the *Aadhaar* card according to which the date of birth of petitioner is 1.1.1986.

In these circumstances when there is no conclusive proof of the educational qualification possessed by the petitioner, we dispose of this petition with liberty to her to pursue the matter before the State Election Commission, Haryana.
