MAIN CASE

The petitioners have filed this civil writ petition
seeking direction to the respondents to decide the representation
dated 19.12.2014 (Annexure P-4) and also to grant regular pay
scale to the petitioners as given to the juniors of the petitioners
those who have been appointed in the year 2003.

The petitioners are working as driver in Haryana
Roadways since 2002. The number of other employees who were
much junior to the petitioners, who have been appointed in the

year 2003, were regularized.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contended that the juniors to the petitioners have been paid regular pay scale of the post from the date of initial recruitment after allowing the benefit of ACP and annual increment as per Haryana Government letter No.1/82/2012-I T (ii) dated 25.06.2014.

The petitioners are claiming parity with the drivers appointed in the year 2003.

A reference has been made to an order passed by Co-ordinate Bench of this Court in CWP No.9990 of 2015 which was disposed of vide order dated 18.05.2015 (Annexure P-6). The petition, at this stage, is disposed of with a direction to respondent-authorities No.2 to decide the representation of the petitioners (Annexure P-4) within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and shall pass a speaking order. If the petitioners are found to be entitled to the relief, then the same shall be granted to them within a further period of one month. However, after the expiry of one month they will be entitled for payment of interest @ 9% per annum from the date when the amount has become due.

The writ petition is disposed of with the above observations.
