Petitioner seeks the grant of benefits of study leave, as per the Study Leave Rules, 1963.

It is the case of the petitioner that he had undergone the course of General Nursing 'A' Grade, after selection, but, on account of the instructions dated 22.03.1993 (Annexure P1), the benefit was not granted. It is the case of the petitioner that the said instructions were subject matter of litigation before this Court and benefit was granted in CWP-3974-2008 titled *Preetam Kaur & others Vs. State of Punjab & others*, decided on 10.01.2011 (Annexure P2).

Counsel for the petitioner submits that a legal notice has already been served upon the respondents on 10.01.2016 (Annexure P4), praying for necessary relief and giving the details of the period for which the petitioner was entitled for the benefit. He further submits that he would be satisfied if action is taken on the legal notice of the petitioner, within a fixed time-frame.

Notice of motion.

Mr.R.S.Sidhu, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Copy of the paperbook has been supplied to him.

Keeping in view the limited relief sought, this Court does not feel it necessary to ask the respondents to file reply.

Accordingly, without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of, with a direction to respondent No.3, to consider and decide the legal notice dated 10.01.2016 (Annexure P4), within a period of 3 months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. In case any adverse order is to be passed, the same shall be conveyed to the petitioner.
