Challenge in the present petition has been made to notice (Annexure P-1) requiring the petitioner to produce certain documents pertaining to the year 2013-14 for the purpose of determining as to whether the petitioner is liable to pay market fee, rural development fund, interest and penalty. The aforesaid communication is sought to be challenged terming the same as a demand notice.

However, a perusal of the aforesaid communication does not show that the same is a demand notice, as it is merely requiring the petitioner to furnish certain documents for the purpose of determination of market fee, rural development fund, interest and penalty, if any, payable. Accordingly, the present petition cannot be entertained as the jurisdiction of the authority as such is not the issue.
