The petitioner has sought direction to the respondents to countersign the certificate of petitioner's experience as Teacher and to consider his candidature for the post of Primary Teacher. Vide order dated 27.04.2015, a co-ordinate Bench of this Court had directed the respondents to interview the petitioner provisionally and the result of the petitioner was to be declared only with the permission of the Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he is willing to forego all other claims and is restricting his prayer only to the entry in the experience certificate issued by the respondents on 03.05.2013 (Annexure R-3), wherein it is recorded that the petitioner was relieved due to police

custody. Learned counsel further contends that this remark casts aspersion on the character of the petitioner and is wholly irrelevant for the purposes of experience.

Learned Senior Deputy Advocate General, Haryana states that it is always open for the petitioner to obtain a fresh experience certificate and the respondents will not record such remark in the experience certificate, which will be issued to the petitioner after he applies for the same.

In view of the aforesaid statement made by learned State counsel, this petition has become rendered infructuous and stands disposed of accordingly.
