1. This petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ of prohibition restraining the respondents from auctioning the Cargo and further a writ of mandamus directing the respondents to release the Cargo lying at Dry Port, ICD, Ludhiana.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that he has instructions to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to avail remedy as may be available to it in accordance with law.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn. However, it shall be open to the petitioner to take recourse to the remedies as may be available to it, in accordance with law.
