The petitioner seeks correction in her father's name in the mark sheet of Session 2013-15 dated 28.5.2015 (Annexure P/1) issued by respondent-Board.

The correction is sought to the extent that word 'Kumar' is missing in the name of the father and only 'Santosh Anuragi' has been mentioned. Reliance has been placed upon the Identity Card issued by the Election Commission of India (Annexure P/3) and Aadhar card (Annexure P/4).

It is not disputed that the petitioner had made representation dated 29.9.2015 (Annexure P/2) to the respondent-Board before filing the present writ petition. The decision making process is not being completed by the respondent-Board though various objections have been taken in the written statement.

In such circumstances, this Court is of the opinion that it would

be appropriate that before the matter is decided by this Court, the Board should give categorical reasons in case the relief is to be denied.

Resultantly, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent Board to decide the said representation dated 29.9.2015 (Annexure P/2) in accordance with law. The respondent-Board shall also consider all the documents which have been appended in support of the writ petition. It is open to the respondent-Board to call for any other necessary document(s), if so required.

Let necessary exercise be completed within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
