This petition is filed for seeking a direction to respondents No. 2 and 3 to restore the electricity by putting a new wire upto the electricity meter.

Counsel for respondents No. 2 and 3 has submitted that the petitioner is a tenant in the shop in question and has a dispute with the land lord who are arrayed as respondents No. 4 and 5. Otherwise, there is no hindrance on the part of the official respondents to provide electricity connection to the meter bearing Account No. ME72-2760. It is also submitted by counsel for respondents No. 2 and 3 that the meter is located within the premises and for the purpose of providing electric wire upto the said meter, it is required to be installed outside the shop.

Counsel for the petitioner has not raised any objection in this regard.

Consequently, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the official respondents to install the meter in question outside the shop in question and provide the electric wire so that the meter may start functioning and may be used by the petitioner for the purpose of getting electricity.

The entire exercise shall be done in the presence of the parties i.e. the petitioner and the official respondents on 2.09.2016.
