The petitioner herein was admitted in MBBS course at Sri Narayan Swami Hospital & Dental College, Dehradun in the year 2008. College was finally not recognised. In litigation pertaining to the recognition, college failed upto Hon'ble the Supreme Court. Only one batch of students was admitted in the college in the year 2008. However, it is submitted that the result of first professional examination was declared in terms of the orders passed by Uttarakhand High Court. The petitioner sought migration in the second professional course in MBBS in respondent No.3 – University. It is not disputed that during the interregnum the petitioner has already completed his engineering course and is now an engineering graduate.

Considering the aforesaid facts and lapse of time, I am of the opinion that no interference is required at this stage.

Accordingly, the present writ petition stands dismissed.
