The petitioners have filed the present petition with a grievance that their application for starting integrated courses of B.A. B.Ed. and B.Sc. B.Ed. is not being considered by National Council for Teacher Education.

In CWP No. 18543 of 2015—Shaheed Captain D. K. Khola Education & Charitable Trust and another v. The Maharishi Dayanand University and another, decided on 25.2.2016, the State furnished the information that during the session 2015-16, out of total intake capacity of 60,672 students in B.Ed. course in different colleges in the State of Haryana, only 32,811 number of seats were filled in spite of grant of extension from last date fixed for admissions and about 40% seats remained vacant.

Considering the aforesaid fact, I do not find any reason to go into the issue of grant of recognition or permission to the petitioners to set up new colleges, as the capacity already available is under-utilised.

The writ petition is accordingly dismissed.
