Counsel for the petitioner submits that he would be satisfied if the Deputy Commissioner, Tarn Taran is directed by this Court to give reasons as to how the case of the petitioner for employment of his son on priority basis is not covered by the Government instructions.

Since the prayer made by the petitioner is innocuous, therefore, the impugned order (Annexure P-8) is hereby set aside and the case is remanded back to the Deputy Commissioner, Tarn Taran to pass a fresh order after giving reasons as to on what basis the claim submitted by the petitioner for the purpose of employment to his son on priority basis in terms of the policies framed by the State of Punjab from time to time to rehabilitate the terrorist affected people is not maintainable.

The petitioner is directed to appear before the Deputy Commissioner, Tarn Taran on 09.05.2016, who shall take the final decision within a period of one month thereafter.
