1. Petitioner has approached this Court under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ in the nature of mandamus for directions to respondent No. 1 to decide his appeal No. 10653 dated 28.04.2014 and to stay the recovery of amount of income tax assessed during the pendency of the appeal.

2. After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that he may be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to avail alternate remedy seeking interim protection from the authorities concerned.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn. However, it shall be open to the petitioner to take recourse to the remedies as may be available to him, in accordance with law.
