At the out set, counsel for respondent No. 5 has submitted that the impugned orders may be set aside and the matter may be remanded back to the State grievance and Redressal Committee(SGRC) to decide the same afresh after giving the petitioner an opportunity of hearing.

However, learned Sr. counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner has submitted that since the petitioner has to receive the payment of ₹ 6,13,625/- on account of the treatment of 123 patients, the said money may be ordered to be paid as soon as the matter is decided by the appellate authority.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Keeping in view the submissions made by respondent No. 5, the order dated Annexures P-22 and 25 are set aside and

the matter is remanded back to SGRC to decide the same after giving opportunity of hearing to the parties.

Parties are directed to appear before the SGRC on 23.05.2016.

It is need less to mention that the decision shall be taken by the SGRC within two months from the date of passing of this order. Parties shall have the right to challenge the order of SGRC in accordance with law.

It is made clear that if the decision is taken in favour of the petitioner, the amount sanctioned by respondent No. 5 shall be paid to the petitioner immediately.
