Rajesh Bindal, J.

The petitioner, which claims to be a NGO, has filed the present petition claiming to be in public interest seeking to issue directions to respondent nos. 2 and 4 to enquire the case of fraud against respondent nos. 5 and 7. It is admitted position in the writ petition itself that number of FIRs have already been registered against respondent no. 5, who was the Managing Director of respondent no.7- company. The FIRs are being investigated. If the complainants therein are aggrieved of any inaction in investigation they are at liberty to avail of their appropriate remedy. It is not a case in which nothing has been done in the alleged fraud committed by respondent no.5. The public interest litigation cannot be entertained. The petition is accordingly dismissed.
