Petitioners seek remuneration as per the 6th Pay Commission, which was implemented in the year 2009 w.e.f. 01.01.2006. It is the case of the petitioners that their pay and pension were revised but the revised remuneration for the re-employment period, i.e., difference between last revised pay and pension, have not been paid. Petitioners' claim is that as per the Ordinance No.2 of 2006 (Annexure P1), teachers who had been re-employed, shall be paid remuneration till the end of the session. The details of the period of re-employment of the petitioners has been mentioned in Annexure P2.

Counsel submits that the petitioners have approached the respondents vide representation dated 22.12.2015 (Annexure P3) for the necessary relief, but the same has not been decided. Reliance is also placed upon directions issued in CWP-15922-2015 titled *Baldev Raj & others Vs. State of Punjab & others*, decided on 17.08.2015 (Annexure P4) wherein, this Court had, in

similar circumstances, directed the respondents to take decision. It has been specifically averred that the petitioners in the said case have been granted the necessary relief and the petitioners are also similarly situated. Counsel submits that the petitioners would be satisfied if the representation dated 22.12.2015 (Annexure P3) is decided, within a fixed time frame.

Notice of motion.

Mr.R.S.Sidhu, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Copy of the paperbook has been supplied to him.

Keeping in view the limited relief sought, this Court does not feel it necessary to ask the respondents to file reply.

Accordingly, without commenting upon the merits of the case and the entitlement of the petitioners, the present writ petition is disposed of, with a direction to respondent No.2, to decide the said claim, within a period of 3 months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order and ensure that the dues are paid to the petitioners. In case the amount is to be denied, a speaking order be passed and the same be conveyed to the petitioners.
