The petitioners seek a direction to the Appellate Authority to decide their stay application in the appeal which they have filed against the order dated 23.2.2016. Since the petitioners are said to have filed the appeal against the eviction order and have taken the plea that a petition seeking declaration of ownership filed under Section 11 of the Punjab Village Common Lands (Regulation) Act, 1961 is still pending, we dispose of this writ petition with a direction to the Appellate Authority to decide the stay application within a period of two weeks however, after hearing the opposite party. Till such application for stay is decided, the parties are directed to maintain

status quo. However, this order shall be applicable only if appeal has been filed along with the stay application.
