RAJESH BINDAL, J.

The petitioner herein is colonizer. He developed the colony after getting licence from the State. The authorities failed to provide water supply. The petitioner was required to take water supply from the boosting station maintained by HUDA.

Learned counsel for HUDA submitted that as a matter of policy, the HUDA decided to permit the colonizers to install tubewells to provide water for domestic and drinking purpose only. For all other requirements, the colonizers will have to take supply of water from the boosting station. The cost of installation of tubewell as calculated by HUDA and communicated to the petitioner vide letter dated 07.11.2016 can be modified by reducing the cost on account of provision for genset and distribution transformer and for chlorinator with two numbers gas cylinders and chlorine analyzer in case the petitioner gives an undertaking that tubewell shall be provided power supply 24 x 7 and will ensure quality of the water supply.

Learned counsel for petitioner submitted that the petitioner will furnish the requisite undertaking and deposit the amount within a period of 10 days.

Learned counsel for the HUDA submitted that the steps for inviting tenders for installation of tubewell will start within two weeks after petitioner furnishes undertaking and deposits the requisite amount. The project shall be completed expeditiously and effort shall be made to complete the same within a period of three months. The schedule of the period in which the installation process will be completed shall be furnished to the petitioner.

In view of the aforesaid stand taken by learned counsel for the parties, the present petition is disposed of.
