Instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari quashing order dated 11.02.2016 (Annexure P/14) passed by respondent No.2 – Director, Rural Development and Panchayat, Punjab, being against the provisions of the Punjab Panchayati Raj Act, 1994 (hereinafter referred to as the “Act”).

Against order dated 11.02.2016 (Annexure P/14) passed by respondent no.2, remedy of appeal under Section 20(6) of the Act is available.

Dismissed. However, if the petitioner files an appeal within 15 days from today before the appellate authority, the same shall be decided on merit, expeditiously preferably within a period of three months after notice to the concerned/opposite party in accordance with law.
