Petitioner-Gurpreet Kaur was selected for the post of Math Mistress against 812 posts advertised on 10.09.2012 in the Reserved Category of Backward Class out of the total 5178 posts of Mistresses in different subjects.

Upon notice, reply has been filed. It has been stated that due to non-appearance of the selected candidates on the appointed dates, the person(s) next in the merit have since been appointed. The result of the petitioner was uploaded on 15.11.2014 and she was required to attend the counselling for scrutiny and placing of documents in the counselling held on 15.11.2014. The petitioner is stated to have abstained from such appearance. The medical grounds for non-appearance set up by the

petitioner were found to be concocted. The petitioner is stated to have abandoned her claim as she got married in Uttar Pradesh on 19.01.2014. The claim of the petitioner is barred by principle of delay and laches.

At the time of hearing, learned proxy counsel for the petitioner states that during the pendency of the writ petition, a speaking order dated 06.05.2016 dismissing the representations of the petitioner has been passed, which requires to be challenged. Hence, he prays for withdrawal the present petition in order to challenge the said order dated 06.05.2016.

In view of above, present petition stands dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.
