Contentends that the matter was remanded back by the Financial Commissioner Appeals-II, Punjab, Chandigarh vide order dated 27.1.2010 mandating the Collector, Hoshiarpur to decide it afresh but despite this no decision has been taken by the Collector in this regard.

Without commending on the merits of the case and noticing the limited prayer made by the petitioner, I would deem it appropriate to dispose of the instant writ petition by giving a direction to respondent No.3 to take a decision in terms of the mandate of the aforestated order by hearing the petitioner as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. Ordered accordingly.
