Admittedly, the petitioner does not have the requisite educational qualifications, as prescribed in the advertisement. The argument raised by the counsel that the petitioner has got higher qualifications is also not sustainable, in view of the fact that the cut-off date has, now, expired, which was 02.12.2015 which had been extended till 10.02.2016, which has, again, gone by. In such circumstances, no relief can be granted to the petitioner. It is for the recruiting agency to fix the educational qualifications and not for the petitioner to dictate as to what should be the correct educational qualifications.

In view of the above, the present writ petition is dismissed in limine.
