In the instant writ petition, the petitioner has questioned the order dated 22.12.2015 by which allotment of Government accommodation to the petitioner has been cancelled on the score that during inspection one Sh. Kabul Singh had occupied un-authorizedly. Annexure P2 cancellation of allotment of house is behind back of the petitioner without giving opportunity to meet the reasons for cancellation. On this short ground Annexure P2 is set aside reserving liberty to the respondents to take action in accordance with law.
