Petitioner seeks the benefit of work-charge service which has been followed by his regularization, for the purpose of pensionary benefits. Reliance has been placed upon CWP-7126-2004 titled *Iqbal Singh Vs. Punjab State Electricity Board*, decided on 23.04.2007 (Annexure P1).

The pleaded case of the petitioner is that he joined the respondent-Corporation in the year 1976 and was regularized on 02.07.1986 and retired on 31.03.2011 and thus, is entitled for counting of his 10 years of service, for the purpose of his pension.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that legal notice dated 26.10.2015 (Annexure P2) has already been served upon the respondents wherein necessary details have been elaborated and the petitioner would be satisfied if the same is decided within a fixed time-frame.

Keeping in view the limited relief sought, this Court does not feel it necessary to ask the respondents to file reply.

Accordingly, without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of, with a direction to respondent No.1, to consider and decide the legal notice dated 26.10.2015 (Annexure P2), within a period of 3 months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. In case any adverse order is to be passed, the same shall be conveyed to the petitioner.
