The petitioner seeks regularisation of his services after completion of 240 days from the date of initial appointment i.e. 16.7.1988.

It is case of the petitioner that he was appointed as Land Valuation Officer on adhoc basis on the above said date with respondent no.3-bank. Thereafter, his services were regularised with effect from 8.9.1990 in view of the decision of the Board of Directors. Similarly situated employees have been regularised after completion of 240 days of their adhoc service. Accordingly, petitioner filed representation dated 7.7.2011 (Annexure P/3) with respondent no.2 and thereafter served a legal notice dated 1.12.2015 (Annexure P/6). It is further case of the petitioner that details of person having been granted similar relief which has been further upheld by this Court has been mentioned in the said legal notice which is now pending consideration.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent no.2 to decide the said legal notice within some fixed time frame.

Keeping in view the limited relief sought by the petitioners, this Court is of the opinion that there is no requirement of calling for any reply

on behalf of the respondents.

Accordingly, without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent no.2 to take into consideration the said legal notice dated 1.12.2015 (Annexure P/6) and pass an appropriate order in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. In case any adverse order is to be passed then a reasoned order be passed by the said respondent and be conveyed to the petitioner.

The present writ petition is disposed off with the aforesaid directions.
