Prayer made in this petition is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing the respondents to vacate the land in question which is alleged to be owned by the petitioner and has been encroached upon by respondent No.7.

During the course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner has referred to a demarcation report in which it is averred that there is encroachment on the land in question which belongs to bus stand. Learned counsel for the petitioner rather submits that the land belongs to him.

In view thereof, the questions involved in this writ petition are questions of facts which cannot be gone into in this petition.

Hence, this petition is disposed of as not maintainable because the petitioner has the remedy of a civil suit.
