S.J.VAZIFDAR, ACTING CHIEF JUSTICE (ORAL):

Issue notice of motion returnable forthwith.

Service waived qua respondent Nos.1 and 2, as Mr. Rajinder Goel, Addl. Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on their behalf. Let a complete set of paper book be supplied to him during the course of the day.

The petitioner seeks an order directing the respondents to take action against the alleged unauthorised occupants of various flats meant for rehabilitating victims of the 1984 riots. The petitioners claim to be entitled to the tenements contending that they hold the necessary documents establishing their entitlement. The petitioners' grievance is that on account of the un-authorised occupation of the tenements, they have been deprived of the same.

The respondents submit that they have already taken action

against the alleged un-authorised occupants. For instance, a public notice has been issued calling upon them to vacate the premises. It is further submitted that upon taking possession from the unauthorised occupants they will place those eligible in possession of the tenements. The petitioners are also at liberty to ascertain from the respondents from time to time about the progress of the action taken and to be taken by the respondents.

The petition is accordingly disposed of.
