Prayer in this application filed under Section 151 of the Civil Procedure Code for disposing of the main case with a direction to the respondents No. 2 and 3 to release the gratuity and to release the full regular pension.

Heard. Application is allowed. The writ petition is taken on Board for hearing today.

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In the application, it is stated that the GPF amount of the petitioner to the tune of ₹35,43,934/- has been released to the petitioner on 09.03.2016 and leave encashment amounting to ₹17,59,500/- has also been released on 15.03.2016. It comes out that the regular pension has been granted to the petitioner vide letter No. 317 dated 19.07.2016 and the same is to be released by the Accountant General, Punjab. Now, the petitioner claims that the gratuity amounting to ₹10.00 lakhs is due to the petitioner. Therefore,

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the prayer is for disposing of this petition by directing the respondents to release the full pension in terms of order dated 19.07.2016 and also to release the gratuity amount.

In view of the matter, the respondents are directed to release the full pension in terms of order No. 317 dated 19.07.2016. It is further ordered to release the gratuity amount due to the petitioner, if there is no legal impediment in releasing the same.

In view of the above, the writ petition is allowed.
