The petitioner is seeking direction to the respondents to grant him arrears of salary from the date of his initial pay fixation, i.e. 10.1.1998.

Vide impugned order Annexure P.7 dated 6.8.2013, the petitioner, who was appointed as a Conductor with the Haryana State Transport Department on contract basis, thereafter, his services as conductor were regularised on 27.12.2000. As per the Government policy decision dated 28.7.1994, the services of conductors were to be regularised after completing two years of service. The petitioner approached this Court by filing CWP No.2508 of 2013 for claiming his date of regularisation w.e.f. 1995, 1996/1997 instead of 27.12.2000.

By the impugned order Annexure P.7, General Manager, Haryana Roadways, Rohtak regularised the services of the petitioner w.e.f. 10.1.1998 in the pay-scale of Rs.3050-75-3950-EB-80-4590 and ordered for fixation of his notional pay w.e.f. 10.1.1998 to 25.8.2003. In the present

writ petition, the petitioner is seeking that his entire arrears of salary should have been paid w.e.f. 10.1.1998. However, since in the present writ petition, the case of the petitioner is being considered only for arrears restricted to 38 months prior to the date of passing of this order, the writ petition is being allowed and the order dated 6.8.2013 (Annexure P.7) is being modified to the extent that this department will give arrears of salary of 38 months to the petitioner.
