Instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari quashing the impugned order dated 12.04.2013 (Annexure P/9) whereby respondent No.2 has refused to register the B.Sc. Nursing (Post Basic) qualification/degree, which was awarded by the Colleges which are affiliated and recognized by Indian Nurses Registration Council as well as by Punjab Nurses Registration Council.

Learned counsel for respondent no.2 states that degrees have been registered by respondent no.2 – Punjab Nurses Registration Council.

The remaining needful is required to be done by respondent no.3 – Haryana

Nurses Registration Council.

Since, the degrees have been registered by respondent no.2, petitioners will be at liberty to move appropriate application to respondent no.3 along with No Objection Certificate and the degree registered by respondent no.2.

If such applications along with other relevant documents are filed by the petitioners, respondent no.3 is directed to take a decision thereon within a period of one month from the date of receipt of the application.

Disposed of in the above terms.
