Learned counsel for respondent No.2 has placed before this Court a communication dated 31.08.2016 addressed to him by the Department, to contend that it has been decided to release the payment on account of earned leave amounting to Rs.63,674/- and gratuity amounting to Rs.3,10,835/- in favour of the petitioner shortly.

In view of the above, present writ petition is disposed of, with a direction to the Managing Director, Confed, Haryana-respondent No.2 to ensure release of the abovesaid amount in favour of the petitioner without any further loss of time and in any case within a period of three weeks from today. Respondent No.2 shall also furnish the complete details of the payments to the petitioners specifically pointing out whether they have included the amount on account of interest as well or not.

After receiving the said communication from respondent No.2, if the petitioner feels not satisfied, he shall be entitled to pursue his remedy, in accordance with law, including filing a writ petition before this Court.

With the abovesaid observations made and directions issued, present writ petition stands disposed of.
