The petitioners have challenged the order dated 11.2.2016 by which they have been removed from the membership of the society in terms of Clause 5(d) of the Constitution of the Society on the ground that they had failed to attend the last three consecutive meetings of the DAV College Hoshiarpur Society (Regd.) at Hoshiarpur.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has fairly admitted during the course of hearing that they have a remedy under the statute to assail the validity of the impugned order. If that is being so, I refrain to interfere in this petition invoking my extraordinary jurisdiction under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India. The petitioners may, if so advised, avail their remedy under the statute.
