Mr. Bakshi, learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent No.2 states that the impugned order of black listing (Annexure P-12) shall stand withdrawn and a fresh order will be passed after affording the petitioner a further hearing. It is clarified that the fresh order shall consider with reasons all the contentions of the petitioner including the defence raised by him for over loading. In the event of the respondents intending to pass a fresh order, they shall serve a fresh notice upon the petitioner of the date of hearing and other relevant dates.

2. The petition is disposed of in the above terms on the basis of the statement made on behalf of respondent No.2. In the event of the proceedings being initiated and in the event of the order being adverse to the petitioner, the same shall not be implemented till 18.07.2016 or for a period of four weeks after the service thereof upon the petitioner whichever is later.
