The challenge in this writ petition filed under Articles 226 and 227 of Constitution of India, *inter-alia*, is to the order dated 04.09.2015 (Annexure P9) passed by respondent No.2, notice dated 07.05.2012 (Annexure P3) and the order dated 10.07.2015 (Annexure P8) issued by respondent No.3.
