The petitioner is aggrieved by an order dated 01.03.2016 passed by the respondents blacklisting it. Disputes and differences between the parties relating *inter alia* to the blacklisting stands referred to the Arbitrator. An application for interim relief in respect of the order impugned in this writ petition has already been filed before the learned Arbitrator under Section 17 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996. The petitioner's grievance is that the application has been made returnable by the learned Arbitrator only on 02.04.2016.

No ground is made out for interfering in the writ petition.

The petitioner can move an application before the learned Arbitrator to advance the date of hearing. Further if the petitioner is aggrieved by the order of the Arbitrator, the same must be challenged in accordance with and under the provisions of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996. It is not a case where the petitioner is without a remedy under the Act.

The petition is accordingly disposed of.
