The petitioner has challenged the condition granting only a week's time to submit a tender.

The work relates to loading and unloading of food grains, labour/cartage for storage centers and P.E.G. godowns. It is understandable therefore that the respondents would want this work to be completed as expeditiously as possible. The first step in this endeavour would be to enter into contracts for the same expeditiously. Seven days time to submit the tender cannot be said to be arbitrary or unreasonable.

The petition is, therefore, dismissed.
