SURYA KANT, J.

The Gram Panchayat of village Laad, Tehsil, Charkhi Dadri, District Bhiwani (respondent No.4) has filed a petition under Section 13-A of the Punjab Village Common Lands (Regulation) Act, 1961 against the petitioner in respect of the land which the petitioner is claiming in possession as a Dohalidar. The Collector passed the order dated 12.11.2013 whereby BDPO was allowed to continue as 'receiver' of the land.

The above-stated order being interim in nature and the grievance of the petitioner being that he has not been given effective hearing before passing the same though disputed by learned counsel

for the Gram Panchayat, we set aside the said order without expressing any views on the merits and direct the Collector, Bhiwani to pass an appropriate order in accordance with law after hearing both the parties. While leaving it open for the Collector to pass appropriate order on the interim issue, it is further directed that the main petition itself be decided within six months.
