Through the present petition, the petitioner seeks counting of the service rendered by him as Assistant Lineman (ALM) on daily wage basis between 01.04.1980 to 17.05.1993 towards pensionable service as also for other retiral benefits.

A perusal of the counter filed by the respondents shows that vide order dated 29.05.2014, the respondents have taken a decision to regularize the afore-referred service of the petitioner rendered by him on daily wage basis and ordered the counting of the same towards pension as also other retiral benefits.

Learned counsel for the petitioner admits to the passing of the afore-referred order and states on instructions that the petitioner is in receipt of revised pension on the basis of the afore-referred order dated 29.05.2014

passed by the respondents, however, he complains that the arrears have not yet been paid.

Learned counsel for the respondents disputes the same and submits that all the arrears through different cheques were offered to the petitioner who refused to receive the same.

Be that as it may and without going into the afore-referred controversy, the respondents are directed to deposit the entire arrears payable to the petitioner in his Bank account, the details of which would be furnished by learned counsel for the petitioner to learned counsel for the respondents within one week from today. The needful be done within one month from the receipt of the information with regard to the Bank details of the petitioner.

The writ petition stands disposed of accordingly.
