The petitioner has challenged a notice under Section 13(4) of the Securitization and Reconstruction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Security Interest Act, 2002 (in short the SARFAESI Act).

2. We see no reason to interfere with the petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India.

3. The petitioner raised certain contentions. After we started dictating the order, the petitioner requested us to leave these issues open for decision in the appeal that the petitioner intends filing under Section 17 of the SARFAESI Act.

4. The petition is, therefore, dismissed with liberty to the petitioner to pursue the alternate remedy.
