Feeling aggrieved against the impugned order dated 05.07.2011 (Annexure P-4), petitioner has approached this Court by way of present writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ in the nature of certiorari, for quashing the impugned order.

Notice of motion was issued and in compliance thereto, respondent No.4 has filed its written statement. Separate reply was filed on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

On having been pointed out by learned counsel for respondent No.4 that this Court vide its order dated 18.02.2009 (Annexure P-1) deciding the earlier writ petition bearing CWP No.8443 of 2011 filed by the petitioner made it clear that so far as the petitioner's claim for interest was concerned, he

would be at liberty to recover the same, if so admissible, as per law, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission of the Court to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to avail his other remedies before the appropriate forum, in accordance with law.

Permission is granted.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty, as prayed for.
