The petitioner seeks ex-gratia compensation on account of death of his father Vishwa Mittar Sahni on 20.7.2007 in harness, who was working as a Salesman in the Shahbad Farmers Co-operative Marketing-cum-Processing Society Limited.

After hearing the learned counsels for the parties, it comes out that the learned counsel for the petitioner has failed to show that the Haryana Compassionate Assistance to the Dependents of Deceased Government Employees Rules, 2006 (Annexure-P-4), which are sought to be invoked by the petitioner, were ever adopted by the respondent-Society.

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It being so, without any Rules, the petitioner cannot claim any
compassionate assistance from the respondent-Society.

Dismissed.
