SURYA KANT, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is a resident of village Ukhalchana (Kot), Tehsil and District Jhajjar. He claims to be living Below the Poverty Line (BPL) to whom the Gram Panchayat decided to allot a plot of 100 square yards. His grievance is that though he is fully eligible for such allotment under the '**Mahatma Gandhi Gramin Basti Yojna**' which the State Government decided to implement vide Policy memo dated 01.02.2008 but the respondents are not considering his claim for undisclosed reasons. It appears from the averments that an exercise to identify the eligible persons was undertaken and the petitioner was found eligible but the follow up action by the Deputy

Commissioner, Jhajjar or Gram Panchayat of their village is still awaited.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and taking into consideration the fact that the petitioner has placed reliance on a Government Policy which, according to him, has not been given effect, we dispose of this writ petition, without expressing any views on the merits, with a direction to respondent nos.3 and 4 to verify the claim of the petitioner as contained in this petition and take an appropriate decision in accordance with law/policy, within a period of four months from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order.

Ordered accordingly.
