The petitioner has approached this Court seeking direction to the respondents to provide him security, which was earlier provided vide order dated 01.10.2010.

Learned counsel for the State submitted that security earlier provided was withdrawn in December, 2012 after reviewing the threat perception to the petitioner. There was no untoward incident. Fresh request was made on 11.02.2013 for providing security. The threat perception was got inquired into and it was found that the petitioner does not require any security.

In view of the aforesaid stand taken by the State, prima facie there is no merit in the present petition. However as learned counsel for the petitioner did not appear though the case was taken up twice, the present petition is dismissed for non-prosecution.
