Learned counsel for the parties are ad idem that petitioner has deposited an amount of ₹67,400/- vide receipt No. 256 dated 5.7.2016.

Learned counsel for respondents No. 2 and 3 also fairly states that nothing is pending against the petitioner either on account of any payment or on account of his eligibility for the release of electric tubewell connection in his favour.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has been found well justified in contending that since now the paddy season is over and fields are lying vacant, it is most appropriate time for the respondent authorities to release electric tubewell connection in favour of the petitioner without any loss of time.

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The abovesaid proposal putforth by learned counsel for the petitioner has not been opposed by learned counsel for the respondents as well.

In view of the above, instant writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the Sub Divisional Officer (OP) Sub Division Cheeka, Uttari Haryana Bijli Vitran Nigam Limited-respondent No.3 to ensure early release of electric tubewell connection in favour of the petitioner and in any case within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

With the abovesaid observations made and directions issued, present writ petition stands disposed of.
