Learned counsel for the State, while referring to the averments taken in para 3 of the affidavit dated 15.7.2016 of Shri Inderjit, Deputy Secretary to Government of Punjab, Department of Revenue and Rehabilitation, submits that the draft rules have been prepared and time for inviting objections expired just yesterday. He further submits that rules shall be finalised within a period of six weeks from today and the instant writ petition may be disposed of, accordingly.

The above-said statement made by the learned counsel for the State has not been opposed by the opposite side.

In view of the above, the instant writ petition is disposed of, with a direction to the State of Punjab through its Financial Commissioner Revenue-respondent No.2, to ensure that the rules are finalised at an early date and in any case within a period of two months from today.
