The petitioner seeks the release of complete retiral benefits along with interest on his superannuation from the post of Sardar Gang No.21 (Labour System) from the office of respondent no.2-Corporation.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that outstanding amounts mentioned in legal notice dated 13.12.2015 (Annexure P/2) which has been served upon the respondents have not been made and no action is being taken on the said legal notice. Counsel further submits that he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the respondent no.2 to decide the said legal notice within some fixed time frame.

Keeping in view the limited relief sought by the petitioner, this Court is of the opinion that there is no requirement of calling for any reply on behalf of the respondents.

Accordingly, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent no.2 to decide the said legal notice dated 13.12.2015 (Annexure P/2) within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. In case any adverse order is to be passed then a reasoned order be passed by the said respondent and be conveyed to the petitioner.

The present writ petition is disposed off with the aforesaid directions.
