Union of India has filed the present appeal against the judgment of the learned Single Judge directing re-evaluation of the medical status of the respondent as he was sought to be invalidated. Till the medical evaluation was completed, invalidation proceedings for boarding out the respondent were kept in abeyance.

Learned counsel for the respondent submitted that before completion of the process, the respondent retired from service on attaining the age of superannuation on 31.12.2015.
